Paradoxically, because of certain technological breakthroughs, the surgical community has reached the tipping point at which further innovation could jeopardize the surgeons' traditional role. Furthermore, therapeutic advances could even make certain surgical treatments obsolete.

But we need to remain confident and, whatever the discipline, our surgical community will most probably cope with future changes.

Unfortunately, facing the future of surgery, the surgeon's referral-dependant position in health care delivery will remain a significant structural weakness.

In contrast to the congress' theme, we specifically invite you to the "Opening Ceremony", dedicated to "The History of Surgery: a Global View", presented by Professor R. Van Hee.

As in the past, all other surgical topics of interest, not necessarily linked to the congress' theme, will be highlighted.

Previous successful modifications to the congress' program will be continued, such as the "Trainer-Trainee session" organized by the BAST, the "Free Video and Papers" Sessions, as well as the "Young Investigator's Award", the "Free Posters", an ethical session and a plenary session focused on the congress' theme.

The Surgical Night will take place on Friday 3rd May 2013, and again this will be a nice opportunity to meet informally with all our colleagues.

And ... for the 15th BSW in 2014, we are pleased to announce you that it will take place again in the Spa Conference Centre.

We look forward to welcoming you again at the Belgian Surgical Week!

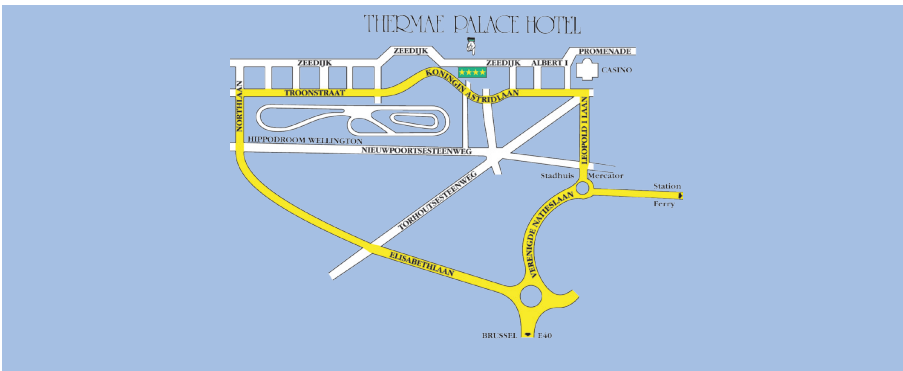
