

#### **EXHIBITION BOOTHS**

The technical exhibition will be concentrated in the large exhibition hall (see plan). The exhibition Hall covers a total area of 972 m<sup>2</sup> (180 m<sup>2</sup> for the Albert I Hall and 792 m<sup>2</sup> for the Albert I Room).
